Regulations on Selection of Recipients for ASE Group
Scholarship

Approved by the 5th Institute General Meeting on Jan.13, 2011
Approved by the 2nd Institute General Meeting on Oct. 22, 2014

Article I Established in compliance with the following:

The Regulations are established in accordance with “National Sun Yat-sen University College of Engineering Implementation Guidelines for ASE Group Scholarship” to select and recommend outstanding students.

Article II Qualifications

The first- and second-year master students and first- to third-year Ph.D. students.

Article III Awardee quota and scholarship amount

1. This scholarship is offered to one outstanding student of the institute every year.
2. After approved, the scholarship will be distributed consecutively, NT\$5,000 per month for twelve months, totally NT\$60,000 a year.

Article IV Operation of Organization

This scholarship is endowed periodically to National Sun Yat-sen University by ASE Group. The execution depends on the endowed budgets. Application to this scholarship is held once every school year. The application will undergo the initial assessment by an assessment committee appointed by the Institute, and then the priority list of candidates will be sent to the College of Engineering, which will convene an executive meeting to reach a resolution. The assessment committee consists of the Director Teaching and Curriculum Committees of the Institute and the Director, who serving as the organizer.

Article V Application Procedure

The applicant should submit the following materials:

1. Application form
2. Resume (1-page A4 paper)
3. Letter of Recommendation from mentor or thesis advisor
4. Transcripts of past semesters

Application must be delivered to the Institute in accordance with the deadlines set by the College of Engineering. The application will undergo the initial assessment by an assessment committee appointed by the Institute, and then the priority list of candidates will be sent to the College of Engineering, which will hold an executive meeting to reach a resolution.

Article VI Assessment proceedings and content

The assessment committee meeting is presided by the organizer. The meeting must be attended by more than one-half of the committee members to reach a valid conclusion. The committee will select the most qualified candidate based on the application materials.

Article VII This regulation is enforced after being approved by the Institute General Meeting. Further Amendments shall be applied as well.
