A master's student (or in-service master's program student) has 13 minutes to do his/her thesis rehearsal and two minutes to answer the questions; i.e., it takes 15 minutes for the student to do the rehearsal. One to two points will be deducted from the total score if it takes less than 12 minutes or exceeds the time limit by 15 minutes to do the rehearsal. (A doctoral student has 15 minutes to do his/her dissertation rehearsal and two minutes to answer the questions; i.e., it takes 17 minutes for the student to do the rehearsal.)
4. Assessment scores will be determined by the faculty members and doctoral students of this Institute. An assessment score given by a doctoral student who works in the same laboratory with the master's student doing the thesis rehearsal will not be included.
5. A note saying that extra points can be given to a local graduate on his/her score for the thesis/dissertation rehearsal in English, such as one extra point for the PowerPoint presentation in English and two extra points for the oral presentation in English, can be added. The total score is 25 .
